
### Pay for a Pane

The parochial church council is applying for grants and is also working hard to raise funds, but we hope that the Friends' efforts will meet any shortfall.

We shall be launching our latest fundraising scheme *Pay for a Pane* on Saturday 10 November, at the tour, and we very much hope that you will all want to contribute. We are taking as our starting point the roundel of St Michael slaying the dragon.
